FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA, USA — The Islam House of Wisdom (بيت الحكمة الإسلامي) — a U.S.-registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit institution — formally announces its establishment as a global Academy of Distinguished Scholars dedicated to reviving the transformative spirit of Baghdad's legendary *Bayt al-Hikma* and channeling its enduring intellectual heritage toward the defining challenges of our era. The Islam House of Wisdom is now actively pursuing the most fitting seat for its academy — a location that reflects the magnitude of its mission, the depth of its scholarly heritage, and its standing as a global institution of civilizational significance.

Vision & Mission

At its founding heart, the Islam House of Wisdom is called to do what the original Bayt al-Hikma did for the medieval world: *gather the finest minds, transcend boundaries, and produce knowledge that transforms civilization*. It will serve as a permanent, independent academy — free from political interference — where scholarship meets wisdom, and where the Islamic intellectual tradition engages the modern world with confidence, creativity, and conviction.

The Islam House of Wisdom will assemble 100 Distinguished Scholars drawn from across the globe, representing the full breadth of Islamic intellectual life and welcoming scholars of all faiths who share a commitment to knowledge, justice, and human flourishing. Membership is by nomination only, exclusively through accredited and well-recognized universities and academic institutions.

The Academy of Distinguished Scholars

The 100 Distinguished Scholars will be geographically distributed to reflect the global nature of the Muslim world and the universality of the institution's mission, drawing from:

- The Arab World – Gulf States, Levant, North Africa
- South and Southeast Asia – Pakistan, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Bangladesh
- Sub-Saharan Africa – Nigeria, Senegal, Tanzania, Mali
- Central Asia and the Caucasus – Turkey, Iran, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan
- Europe and the Americas – United Kingdom, France, Germany, United States, Canada
- International Distinguished Scholars of all faiths – nominated for exceptional contribution

Nominations are accepted exclusively through accredited, well-recognized universities and academic institutions. No self-nominations or political appointments are accepted. The selection process is governed by an independent Academic Council committed to scholarly excellence and integrity.

Six Domains of Scholarship

The Distinguished Scholars will engage across six transformative domains, each addressing a critical dimension of Islamic intellectual life and global civilization:

- I. **Islamic Jurisprudence & Legal Reform** – Reinterpreting classical Sharia scholarship for contemporary governance, human rights, and global jurisprudence – building bridges between tradition and modernity.
- II. **Islamic Economics & Finance** – Advancing ethical, equitable economic frameworks rooted in Islamic principles – addressing poverty, development, and global financial justice.
- III. **Science, Technology & Innovation** – Reconnecting the Islamic Golden Age's scientific heritage with artificial intelligence, medicine, biotechnology, and modern research – reclaiming Islam's role at the frontier of human knowledge.

IV. Governance, Peace & Conflict Resolution – Developing scholarly frameworks for just governance, Sunni-Shiite reconciliation, and durable peace – providing intellectual leadership where it is most urgently needed.

V. Arts, Architecture & Philosophy – Celebrating and reviving the Islamic aesthetic and intellectual traditions as living, dynamic contributions to world culture and human identity.

VI. Interfaith Dialogue & Global Ethics – Fostering sustained scholarly engagement across faiths toward shared ethical foundations, mutual understanding, and a common vision for humanity's future.

Inaugural Conference: From the Golden Age to the Digital Age

Islam House of Wisdom will launch its public program with a landmark inaugural international conference bearing the theme: *"From the Golden Age to the Digital Age."* This historic gathering will bring together scholars, diplomats, institutional leaders, and visionaries from across the Muslim world and the global academic community to chart a course of intellectual renewal and civilizational contribution for the 21st century.
